Is it Love vs Judgement?









When he opened the second seal heard the second living creature call out, 'Come!' And out came another horse, sword. bright red;

But are not the 4 Horsemen the results of human action?



The wrath of God is God giving over humans to the consequences of human sin.



When he opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slaughtered for the word of God and for the testimony they had given; they cried out with a loud voice,



'Sovereign Lord, holy and true, how long will it be before you judge and avenge our blood on the inhabitants of the earth?'



They were each given a white robe and told to rest a little longer, until the number would be complete both of their fellow-servants and of their brothers and sisters, who were soon to be killed as they themselves had been killed. (6:10-11)



'a little longer ...'


Divine patience with human sin so that more may have time to repent


